

WET WEATHER POLICY

	Allocated areas during: Non threatening or Severe Weather	Allocated areas during: Severe Weather
Classes who are rostered to be on hard courts.	Remain in the Undercover Area supervised by the duty teacher in that area.	If severe weather occurs during break times, students are to move to the allocated areas until further notice.
Classes who are rostered to be on the oval and oval playground (lunchtime only).	Move to the Library and are supervised by a member of the Admin team and/or the library teacher.	Teachers will be notified before recess or lunch breaks if severe weather is approaching or if the following measures will take place.
Classes who are rostered to be on the Hall.	Remain in the hall with the oval/hall duty teacher.	In threatening, heavy rain or storm weather students will remain in their classes with their classroom teacher. Admin team members and non-classroom teachers are expected to offer relief for classroom teachers to have a short break.
Pre-Primary Area – PP and some or all Year 1 students.	PP students (and Year 1s) go into the PP undercover area or PP room. Supervised by the duty teacher in that area.	
Students who are in the library during lunchtime.	Leave the library and move to there designated lunchtime play area for that day. They remain in the library if they were previously rostered on the oval.	At the conclusion of the lunch or recess the bell will ring to let teachers know that lessons may commence.

- Canteen will still operate between 12.45pm and 1.15pm. The children may purchase items at this time.
- At the end of lunch or recess all teachers and children will return to their classes.
- If the weather appears to clear and remains stable, the children will be released to play in their allocated play areas based on the Playground Roster.
